Disputes arose between the parties which were referred to the arbitration and the award pronounced on 01/08/2016 was not in favour of the company. Aggrieved by the decision, the company appealed before the Hon'ble Delhi High Court and S M Milkose Limited too approached the same Court seeking performance of the arbitral award.</p> <p>After hearing the parties, the Hon'ble High Court, vide judgment dated 27 November 2025, dismissed the Company's appeal and upheld the arbitral award.</p>

Expected financial implications, if any, due to compensation, penalty etc	<p>The claim in the litigation based on the arbitral award is estimated at about Rs. 6.5 crore as on this date.</p> <p>The company has already recognized a provision of Rs. 3.33 crore in the books of account. Considering this judgment, an additional provision of Rs. 3.17 crore shall be recognized during the current quarter.</p>
c	Quantum of claims if any	Estimated claim amount is about Rs. 6.5 crore.
